Using White Rose, Year 2 will focus on place value for the first half of the term.

We will be using resources such as place value grids and dienes to help understand the place value of a number.

For the second half of the term we will focus on addition and subtraction. The children will be able to add 2-digit numbers crossing tens.



## Curious City Enquiry

This will be our first exciting enquiry in Owl Class! The children will be Scientists, Engineers and Artists.

We will be learning if materials are either natural or made and are used in buildings and parts of construction for a reason, not just because they look good.
