

Autumn 2 Enquiry: How can we show what we believe in?

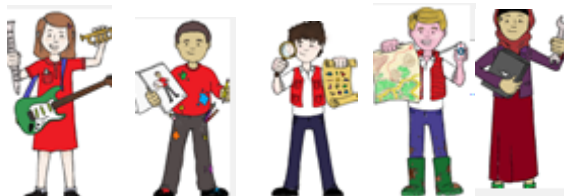
Being Authors & Readers

- We will be practising descriptive writing, writing about 'The Magical Picture'.
- We will be writing descriptions of Mayan gods.
- We will be using the book 'The Snow Sister' to write newspaper reports.
- We will be completing grammar, spelling and reading activities appropriate for our year groups.
- We will also be reading for pleasure and sharing stories wherever we possibly can!



Being Artists, Engineers, Musicians, Historians and Geographers

- We will be learning about the early Mayans. Who they were, what they did and what they believed.
- We will discuss how we know about them by what was left behind.
- We will explore worship and beliefs, and iconography and symbolism.
- We will use our developing drawing skills to create perspective drawing and add depth to our pictures.



Being Mathematicians

Year 4 will be adding and subtracting 4-digit numbers, measuring area and multiplying and dividing whilst securing our timetables. We will continue to use TTRS to support us.

Year 5 will be finding multiples, factors, cube numbers and square numbers, multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1,000, and measuring length, perimeter and area.
