Spring Enquiry: Where is our twin?

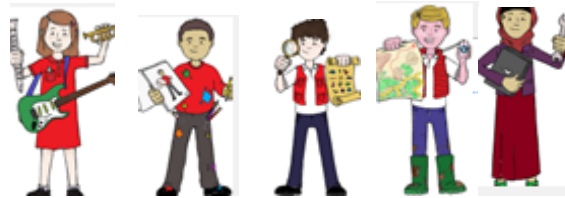
Being Authors & Readers
