Art/Engineering

As Engineers, we will be analysing pop ups in books and on cards. We will then be making our own pop up pages for a book about things that move.

History/Geography

Mathematics

As Mathematicians, we will be working on Place value (within 50): We will be counting in tens and ones, partitioning numbers and estimating amounts. We will learn to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10. We will find out about length and height - comparing, measuring and using centimetres. We'll enjoy mass and volume - comparing and measuring mass, volume and capacity.

Computing

We will be learning about data. We will match and label data, describe objects, group data and compare different groups.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about healthy choices with our food and our activity. We will also think about how we can stay safe and how to deal with tricky situations.
