Enquiry: How can Science help the vulnerable?

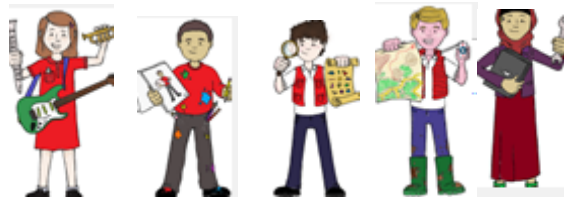
Being Authors & Readers
