Geography

As geographers, we will be learning about the physical features of our planet. We will find out about tectonic plates, volcanoes and earthquakes, and why they occur. We will use maps and atlases to locate countries of the world.

Scientists

As scientists, we will be learning about rocks and soil. We will find out about how rocks are formed and compare different types of rocks. We will also learn how fossils are formed. We will dissect soil to see what it is made of. Our enquiry challenge will be to create a flowchart of how rocks and soil are formed for a geologist to display at their work place.



Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will continue to learn our 4- and 8-times tables, alongside practising our 2s, 3s, 5s and 10s. We will be learning about fractions and then we will move onto a topic about mass and capacity. We will use practical equipment to measure and also be using this as a context for our problem solving. Our daily arithmetic practice will continue.

Music
