In Drawing Club we will continue to develop our pleasure for reading, explore vocabulary and listen to and discuss a range of stories and poems. We will be writing about the stories and poems composing our sentences orally before writing. We will be trying to write more and extending our sentences by using simple conjunctions and by adding exciting vocabulary. We will be regularly practising reading a range of real and alien words in preparation for our Phonics screening in June.



Physical Education

As Athletes we will be working on our agility, learning to move in different directions; keep our bodies safe in running games. Science

As Scientists, we will find out about the plants that grow near us. We will learn to identify and name a number of these plants, including trees. We will learn about the basic structure of plants. We will also enjoy finding out about the small creatures that live near us and enjoy watching the caterpillar life cycle first-hand. We will enjoy growing some plants of our own to sell!



Geography

As Geographers we will be thinking about the plants that grow right here, where we live and also about those that grow far, far away in different countries and have to be transported across the world for us to enjoy.



Art/Engineering

As Engineers, we will be finding out where our food comes from. We will learn how to prepare a snack using tools safely.



As Artists, we will be using line, shape, form, texture and pattern to draw plants from observation.

Mathematics

As Mathematicians, we will start by exploring length and height – comparing items and then learning to measure using centimetres. Next, we will learn about mass and volume – making comparisons and using lots of new vocabulary. We will then begin multiplication and division using grouping and sharing. We will be counting in 2s, 5s and 10s as a start to learning our times tables. Finally, we will be working on fractions, recognising and finding halves and quarters of shapes and amounts.



Computing

As Computer Engineers we will develop our understanding of the various aspects of using a computer to create and manipulate text. We will become more familiar with using a keyboard and mouse to enter and remove text. We will learn how to change the look of their text. Finally, we will consider the differences between using a computer to and writing on paper - explaining which method they prefer and reasoning why.



PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about relationships, focusing on family, friends and people who help us. We will also learn about how we can be a friend to ourselves!
