## Curious City Enquiry



Our next enquiry – ‘How do plants grow near me?’ focuses on plants, how and where they grow. Owl Class will begin by identifying and naming a range of plants, fruits and vegetables and draw them focusing on colour and texture of skin. We will then look at a seedling plant and draw the roots, creating a detailed line drawing. We will be completing simple tests using a variety of seeds in a pot placing them in different areas, without light or without water. We will look at different plants from a range of countries, and talk about type of climate. We will then explore and label different parts of a flowering plant as well as select what plants we would like to plant in a sensory garden and explain why.

Our challenge is to create a ‘Plantopedia’ for potted plants with a labelled explanation and descriptive drawing.
