As authors, we will continue whole class reading of a range of different text types. We will also continue learning the Year 3 spelling rules, punctuation and grammar features. We will be reading information texts to find out about explorers. We will also be writing a sequel to a story and a newspaper report. As our enquiry challenge, we will be writing a class sea shanty.

Physical Education

As athletes, we will develop our skills in rounders. We will also be practising our striking and fielding in cricket.

Religious Education

In RE we are focussing on Judaism. We will look at the symbols and stories that help Jewish people remember their covenant with God.

Computing

This term we explore the links between events and actions, whilst consolidating prior learning relating to sequencing. Learners will begin by moving a sprite in four directions and conclude with designing and coding their own maze tracing program.

Historians

As historians, we will be finding out about travel in the past. We will look at why we travel now and reasons for travel in History. We will be learning about famous explorers including Matthew Henson and Ernest Shackleton.

Geography

As geographers, we will be looking at travel and transport. We will be looking at maps and atlases to find the countries visited and routes that explorers used in the past.

Mathematics

As mathematicians, we will learn about angles including right angles, comparing different types of angles and investigating different lines. We will then move on to recognising and drawing 2D and 3D shapes. We will finish the year by learning about statistics concentrating on pictograms and bar charts. Our daily arithmetic and times table practice will also continue.

Music

As musicians, we are going to be learning about and performing sea shanties. We will then write our own sea shanty, which we will perform.

PSHCE

In PSHCE, we will be learning about families, babies and how our bodies change as we grow up.

As linguists, we will be learning how to say 'Je peux...' meaning 'I can...' alongside verbs in French.
